Gaitway Therapeutic Horsemanship (hereinafter known as GaitWay) policy requires volunteers to be at least 14 years old. Exceptions can sometimes be made for approved 13 years old by completing the following form.

GaitWay volunteers must be mature enough and, when handling the horse, knowledgeable enough about horses, to react appropriately in an emergency situation. They must also be tall enough, when serving as sidewalkers, to assist the rider. **A parent/ legal guardian must attend Volunteer Orientation and Training with the underage volunteer** in order to know what is required of a GaitWay volunteer.
